

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Lafayette County Commission will be holding a public hearing on January 22, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Commissioner's Meeting Room, on the second floor of the Lafayette County Courthouse, to consider adopting the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-01-01

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS BY THE UNIFORM METHODOLOGY PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Lafayette County (hereinafter the "County") is a local government as that term is defined in Section 197.3632(b) of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the County has levied non ad valorem assessments pursuant to Florida law as permitted in s. 4, Art. X of the State Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, authorizes the County to elect to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments as authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes for any assessment levied pursuant to general or special law or local government ordinance or resolution, regardless of when the assessment was initially imposed or whether it has previously been collected by another method.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA;

Section 1. The County affirms that the preamble "whereas" clauses are true, correct and incorporated herein as dispositive.

Section 2. That the collection and enforcement of the aforesaid assessments under the supervision of the Florida Department of Revenue shall be by the Tax Collector and shall be at the same time and in like manner as ad valorem taxes and subject to all ad valorem tax collection and enforcement procedures which attend the use of the official annual tax notice using the uniform method.


Section 3. Be it further resolved, that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the proper public officials so that its purpose and effect may be carried out in accordance with law.
