Per our conversation on Friday below is the breakdown of added hours to complete the added scope change. The total amount for this change order is **\$23,488.00**

- 10-15 RFRS as of 10/26/20 (subject to change based on remaining purchases) **80 hours**
- 65 total payments as of 10/26/20 have been completed
- Create a subrecipient agreement for Town of Mayo to purchase debris removal truck. has legal determined that this is eligible
- Extended SBA through 11/30/20 roll-over option (1x a week on site to collect SBA's and validate SBA's). Also, on site for approval of SBA's Nov. 9<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> to submit recommendations of approved small businesses. 7 days X 2 people =14 days X 9 = **126 hours**
- Final reports for FDEM and Closeout. **40 hours**
