The annual reorganization meeting of the Lafayette County Board of County Commissioners was held on November 17, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. with the following members present: Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

The meeting was called to order by Steve Land, Clerk of Court. The floor was opened for nominations for Chairman. Mr. Jones nominated Mr. Adams for Chairman. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the board voted unanimously for nominations to cease. Mr. Adams assumed the duties of the Chair. The floor was opened for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Mr. Lamb nominated Mr. Jones. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. McCray, the board voted unanimously for nominations to cease.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to re-appoint all members to the committees on which they are currently serving. The following County Commissioners were appointed to the following Boards: North Florida Regional Planning Council – Anthony Adams; Economic Development – Henry McCray; Small County Coalition – Earnest Jones and Anthony Adams; Three Rivers Regional Library Board – Lance Lamb; and Transportation Disadvantage Health Planning Council – Lisa Walker.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all Department Heads which include the following – Scott Sadler as Public Works Director; Garret Land as Building/Zoning Official; Marcus Calhoun as County Maintenance; Marty Tompkins as EMS Director; and Deborah Johnson as County Library Manager.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all Custodians which include the following: Alicia Swinson at the Day Community Center; Helen Bennett at the Airline Community Center and the Mayo Community Center; Courtney Kight at the Fourth District Community Center; and Tina Finch at the Courthouse and Extension Office.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all positions that are under the Department Heads.

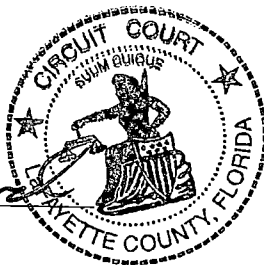
