INDUSTRIAL PARK TENANT PAST DUE RENT

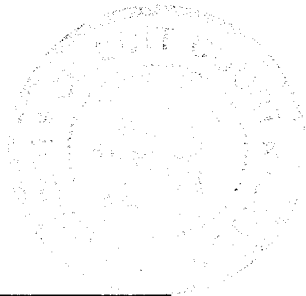
Mr. Drew Bell, with Bell's Cabinet Shop, discussed a recent eviction notice he received from the Board. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to accept a proposal for Bell's Cabinets to do the following: catch up 2012 rent by May 1, 2012, pay their monthly rent on time, pay \$200.00 monthly on prior 12/31/11 balance of \$14,307.76, pay more on the arrears when they can, and the Board will review their position in 90 days.


SUWANNEE RIVER ECONOMIC COUNCIL SHIP FUNDING


Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Board of County Commissioners to change the maximum participation of Owner Occupied Rehabilitation projects.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the County Commission of Lafayette County, Florida:


That the maximum participation of Owner Occupied Rehabilitation projects be raised to \$40,000.00.

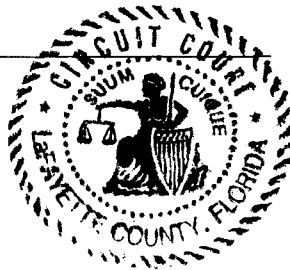
