

REGULAR MEETING

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Representatives from the Florida Department of Transportation came before the Board to discuss the CR 354A/CR 416 upcoming project. No action was taken on this issue.

SUWANNEE RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT PRESENTATION

Abby Johnson, with the Suwannee River Water Management District, presented the Board with a check in the amount of \$76,960.69 for their annual payment in lieu of taxes. No action was taken on this issue.

UNIFORMS FOR PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Public Works and Maintenance Departments getting uniforms at the employees' expense. There will be a payroll deduction for the uniforms.

MARTY TOMPKINS – EMS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to give Marty Tompkins, Lafayette County EMS Director, permission to use county awarded grant money to purchase computer equipment.

RETURN VEHICLE TO TIM SMOAK

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to return the Ford Explorer to Tim Smoak that was used as an Emergency Response vehicle because it is no longer needed.

APPLY FOR GRANT FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT

The Board, upon general consent, agreed to allow Mr. Marty Tompkins to apply for a grant for equipment to be used at the Day Volunteer Fire Department.

COUNTY CREDIT CARD

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve raising the limit on the County credit card to \$5,000.00.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to authorize Mr. Donnie Hamlin to sign documents for the new county group Health Insurance.
