RESOLUTION 2013-8-SP-1


WHEREAS, Recent rainfall has produced flooding throughout Lafayette County, Florida and

WHEREAS, the rain and flooding throughout the County could endanger the citizens lives, homes and welfare.

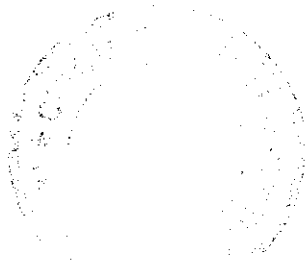
