AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86-2: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY AND THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF MAYO, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE TOWN OF MAYO, CREATING A MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES. AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF MUNICIPAL BENEFIT SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AND TAXES WITHIN THE UNIT, ESTABLISHING BUDGETING, ASSESSMENT AND LEVY PROCEDURES; PROVIDING VARIANCES, PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND INTERPRETATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the Board to enter into and execute such agreement.


