The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

SCOTT KOONS – NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL

Mr. Scott Koons, with the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council, made a presentation before the Board. No action was taken on this issue.

FLORIDA MUNICIPAL INSURANCE TRUST

Mr. John Pat Thomas, with Florida Municipal Insurance Trust, presented the Board with a check in the amount of \$12,887.00 for a return of the premium. No action was taken on this issue.

CDBG GRANT UPDATE

Mrs. Debbie Belcher gave the Board an update on the CDBG Grant. She will be holding a pre-bid meeting on December 20, 2012 for the last project of the grant and will have the bids ready to be opened at the meeting on January 14, 2013.

The Board and Mrs. Belcher discussed the Energy Grant and the reimbursement that hasn't been received yet on this Grant. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Ricky Lyons send a letter to Commissioner Putnam about the six month time period it has been to get the reimbursement.

MARCUS CALHOUN – COUNTY MAINTENANCE

Mr. Marcus Calhoun discussed bids he received for purchasing a new walk behind floor scrubber that can be used at all the Community Centers and the Courthouse to clean the floors. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to go with the bid in the amount of \$5,500.00 from Osceola Supply to purchase their machine. The machine was the middle quote but future service needs was the reason for not going with the lowest quote.

Mr. Calhoun also discussed repairing the roof at the Jail with the Board. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to advertise re-roofing the Jail.

TREVOR HICKS – EMS

Mr. Trevor Hicks discussed having the First Responders complete a required Basic First Responder Course with the Board. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the course.

NORTH FLORIDA BROADBAND AUTHORITY

The Board discussed Lafayette County's participation with the North Florida Broadband Authority. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, with Mr. Jones abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to withdraw their membership in the North Florida Broadband Authority.

INDIGENT BURIAL APPLICATION

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve an Indigent Burial application from ICS Cremation and funeral home dated December 7, 2012. The invoice is on file in the Clerk's Office.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with the exception of the Byrd's Power Equipment bill, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

General Fund - \$351,301.31
Emergency 911 Fund - \$1,223.47
Industrial Park Fund - \$1,980.00

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with Mr. Byrd abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Byrd's Power Equipment bill in the amount of \$58.47.

ADJOURN

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

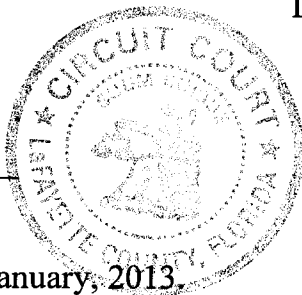

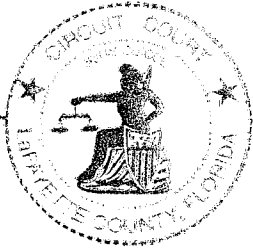

TERMS OF DONATION
