The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

**APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES REPRESENTATIVE**

Mr. John Pat Thomas, with the Florida League of Cities, presented the Board with a check in the amount of \$11,032.00 for the County's rebate from its membership in F.A.C.T.

**REQUEST FROM RESIDENT ON ROOSEVELT CIRCLE**

Mrs. Yvonne Giles, a resident who lives on Roosevelt Circle, discussed the possibility of having her road made a One-Way street and trying to get it paved. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to hold a Public Hearing with all of the residents on that road and get their input to it as well. The Board also told Mrs. Giles that they would talk to the Department of Transportation to see about getting this road on the Five Year Work Plan.

**ROAD WORK ON NE PECAN AVENUE**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the list of proposed road work to be done on NE Pecan Avenue. (See attached.)

**MARTY TOMPKINS, EMS DIRECTOR**

Mr. Marty Tompkins, EMS Director, discussed the resignation letter from Regina Byrd and his ideas on how to fill her vacant shift by using EMT's currently

working to fill her spot and to keep it as a part time position. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to accept Mrs. Byrd's resignation letter and to approve the recommendation of Mr. Tompkins about filling her position.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to schedule the meeting on December 22, 2014 at 12:00 p.m. instead of 5:30 p.m. due to the Christmas Holidays to approve the Warrant List and to add the Health Department to the agenda to discuss with the State about filling the position vacated by Pam Blackmon.

**CR 416 REPAIRS**

The Board discussed the repairs to CR 416. Mr. Scott Sadler and Mr. Anthony Adams are going to research the cost of preliminary fixes/repairs to the road. No action was taken on this issue.

**FLOODING IN SW PART OF MAYO**

The Board discussed the flooding issues in the SW part of Mayo and how to repair and prevent future damage. No action was taken on this issue.

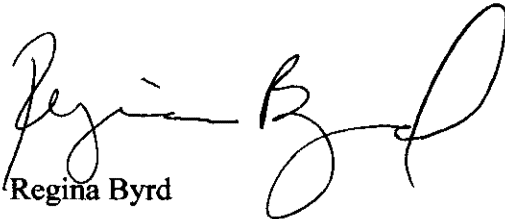

Proposed NE Pecan Ave Road Work

Lafayette Board of County Commissioners,

I'm writing to you to inform you of an opportunity to perform some much needed road work on NE Pecan Ave. For background information, NE Pecan Ave. intersects CR 354 on the south end and terminates on the north at the Hardenburg boat ramp and park. Pecan Ave. is an access road for 18 parcels of land and the county boat ramp and park. The first 2550 feet of this road is narrow only 14 feet wide in some places. There have been numerous complainants about the width of this section of the road. There have also been numerous wrecks involving the trees that line and sometimes protrude into the road. (Please see attached picture for reference too trees protruding in the road) This section of road is line on the west side by Mr. Lindsey Jackson's property and on the east side by Mr. Wroten Land's property. Mr. Land has recently cut the pines off his property, which created an opportunity to contact him about the removal of the trees that line the east side of the road.

Mr. Land was contacted by Commissioner Hamlin and me about the possibility of removing these trees. Mr. Land, Commissioner Hamlin, and I meet Tuesday December 2, 2014 at 3:30pm on site at NE Pecan Ave. At this meeting we talk to Mr. Land about the removal of trees and straightening and widening of the existing road. Mr. Land was agreeable to coming 20 ft off of the existing fence on the west side of the road and clearing all trees within this area. He was also agreeable to regrading the existing road to a width of 20 ft. His only concern was that the road could get wider over the years because of grading. He ask if we precede with this project that after the road is widen to the 20 foot limit that a boundary be placed at 21 foot so no other widening would occur in the future. After discussion about the removal of trees from this area several options where proposed.

There are two viable options for tree removal is this area. The first would be for the county Road Department to cut down all trees, removing all debris by hauling all trunks and large pieces of wood off site and piling all tops and branches on Mr. Land's property for burning when he burns his pine debris. Mr. Land has given permission for the piling and burning of these limbs on his property. The second option would be to have some one come in and chip these hardwood trees. This would relieve the county of the wear and tear on equipment and the cost of labor for this project.

I'm currently talking with Mr. John Cruce of Perry, Fl who is in the Hatch Bend Area chipping wood at this time. I hope to have more information for you on this subject at the board meeting on December the 8<sup>th</sup>. These things I do know about the chipping option; 1.)Mr. Land says that to entice a chipping crew to come to this project he is willing to let them chip other hardwood on his property while they are there if this would help to get them there. 2.) Their would probably be no payment given for the hardwood. They would simply chip the wood for the wood itself. Both options would leave stump removal for the county Road Department to perform.

Mr. Land in the meeting on Tuesday voiced his concerns for public safety on this portion of NE Pecan Ave. and was very willing to help in any way to rectify the dangers that the tree line poses to the safety

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of this portion of the road. This is an opportune time to try and rectify this problem being Mr. Land has cut his pines and there is room to remove problem trees without damaging property or marketable timber. In closing if the Board deems this a worthy project and would give me permission I would like to move forward with finding the best option for the County for tree removal and all work need for reshaping this road.
