I have reviewed Mr. Huggett's and Mr. Roddenberry's attached Paramedic applications and their county background checks and find no reason for denying them part time employment. If you concur please ask Mr. Lyons to notify Trevor so that he can start scheduling them as needed. Please note that Mr. Huggett' is Firefighter I, & II certified and Mr. Roddenberry is a certified rescue diver.

Mr. Charlie L. Connor, Director of Suwannee County Public Safety, has advised Trevor that he would be available to work from 8 P.M. on Friday to 8 P.M. on Sunday on an as needed basis. With the board's concurrence we would like to hire Mr. Connor as a part time employee.

At the present time our county is short one full time paramedic and with Ms. Langford being unable to work for the better part of January due to a medical procedure, it will require our remaining Paramedics to work quite a bit of overtime to cover all shifts. By hiring some part-time paramedics we hope to keep the overtime to a minimum.

Also attached are three copies of Dr. Spindell's Medical Directors Contract. Trevor and I have reviewed the contract and found no changes from the current contract. Ms. Leenette has some concerns and will discuss them with the board at the meeting on Monday, Dec 20<sup>th</sup>.

After thoroughly reviewing the three bids that were submitted for the VFD Tanker Truck it was decided to award the contract to Fouts Bros. of Smyrna Ga. They were the only company that met all the required specifications. E-One was eliminated because it was the highest bid. Pierce was the lowest bidder by \$1,042 however they did not meet the required specification of a 350 HP or greater engine. In addition Fout Bro. agreed to come to the Fire Department and mount all equipment required by NFPA 1901 per our department's instruction, plus they will provide 8 hours of training on operation of the tanker and will perform the first year servicing and required pump test at no charge. Mr. Robinson and Mr. Hart are going to notify Fouts Bro. that they have

been awarded the contact on Monday afternoon. If you have any questions please call Mr. Hart and he will attend the noon BoCC and try to answer them for you.
