Pridgeon, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan.

#### APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

#### LAFAYETTE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Ms. Melissa Pearson with the Lafayette County Health Department requested permission from the board to put flags and a banner on the front lawn of the Courthouse for Cancer Awareness and the Relay for Life. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously to allow the flags and banner to be put on the front lawn.

#### HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT WITH MAYO THRIFTWAY

The board reviewed a Hold Harmless Agreement that the County has with Mayo Thriftway to provide them with a generator should there be a hurricane disaster. The board wanted Ms. McMillan to add a clause to the agreement that if all extra generators are loaned out, the County would be held harmless in that situation. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Byrd, the board voted unanimously to approve the agreement pending Ms. McMillan making that change.

#### INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH SUWANNEE COUNTY

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the board voted unanimously to approve an Interlocal Agreement with Suwannee County for Building Official services to be performed by Mr. Bobby Johnson.

#### JANUARY BUILDING DEPARTMENT/SOLID WASTE REPORTS

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously to approve the January Building Department and Solid Waste reports.

#### APPOINT REPRESENTATIVE TO HEALTHCARE COUNCIL

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Steve Tullos to the Second Congressional District's Healthcare Council.
