The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

LAFAYETTE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD PERMIT FEE WAIVER

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve waiving all permit fees for the Lafayette County School Board instead of them having to send in a request letter each time.

MARTY TOMPKINS – LAFAYETTE COUNTY EMS

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve giving Marty Tompkins, Lafayette County EMS Director, the authority to move an employee from part-time to full-time status.

HEALTH INSURANCE COMMITTEE

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Committee to review the Health Insurance proposals. The Committee consists of the following people: Anthony Adams, Phyllis Branch, Donna Dennis, Scott Sadler, Marty Tompkins, Steve Land, Lori Fredriksson and Ricky Lyons.

STEINHATCHEE SPRINGS PROPERTY

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve purchasing a lot from the Grover Lawson heirs which is adjacent to the Steinhatchee Bridge. The bridge is to be replaced in the future and this would give the county more access. The purchase price is \$10,000. The

closing costs are to be shared with the owner. Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson is designated to handle all of the closing documents.

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-7-1-1

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to adopt Resolution No. 2015-7-1-1 approving Supplemental Agreement #5 for the CR 300 SCOP project.

PROPERTY DONATION FOR DAY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

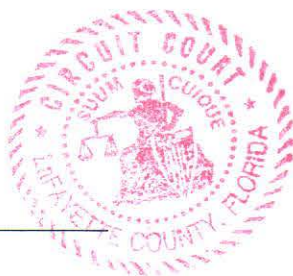


ADJOURN TO TOUR THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT
