The Board held a special meeting to discuss a letter received from James Helinger, Jr., P.A. in reference to parcel number 18-05-12-0056-0000-00040 (see attached). The letter was concerning a ditch the county dug across part of the property to relieve some flooding in some homes on 10 mile pond. The Commissioners discussed the value of the ditch.


