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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2 (by phone); Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

DELORES WALKER – VARIOUS ITEMS

Delores Walker addressed the Board to voice her concerns about the condition of Wayfare Cemetery and the condition of Circle Drive. She asked that the Board have the cemetery cleaned up, and said that there are some limbs that need to be picked up on the right-of-way and also mowing to be done. The Board and Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, discussed her concerns and a possible resolution. No action was taken on this issue.

CANVASSING BOARD MEMBER





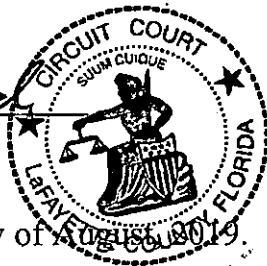
