

REGULAR MEETING
JULY 9, 2012
9:00 A.M.

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

CHRIS JOYNER – REQUEST FOR A PRIMITIVE CAMPING PERMIT

Mr. Chris Joyner requested a primitive camping permit at his property for people that come to his mud bogging activities and want to stay overnight. After discussion with the Board, on a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to delay their decision until Mr. Bobby Johnson, Lafayette County Building Inspector, talks to the Health Department about this and reports back to the Board at the next meeting.

RESOLUTION DECLARING JULY AS WATER SAFETY MONTH

A representative with the Department of Children and Families discussed with the Board a Resolution declaring July as Water Safety Month. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution.

DONNIE LAND – INDUSTRIAL PARK

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to allow Mr. Ed Keith to rent the old Marine Diving Building at the Industrial Park.

TREVOR HICKS – EMS

Mr. Trevor Hicks discussed air conditioning problems on Rescue 5 and a starter problem they are having on Rescue 3 and requested permission to have

them repaired. Upon general consent of the Board, they agreed to allow Mr. Hicks to have the repairs done.

DEBBIE BELCHER – CDBG GRANT

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve a change order request in the amount of \$1,500.00 from Freeman Design Group, Inc. to redesign the 3 bedroom house plans.

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to open bids for CDBG Bid Package 3 on August 6, 2012 at 12:00 p.m.

LETTER REGARDING FSA CLOSING

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to send a letter to Senator Nelson, Senator Rubio and Representative Southerland asking them what efforts they made to save the FSA office from closing and request a reply.

JUNE BUILDING DEPARTMENT & SOLID WASTE REPORTS

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the June Building Department and Solid Waste billing reports.

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND STATE OF EMERGENCY

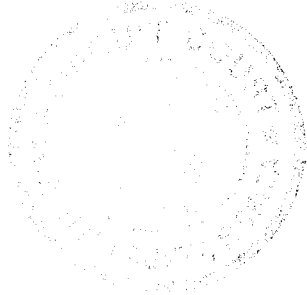


ACCEPT CHECK FROM INSURANCE COMPANY


ADJOURN

<i>Whereas,</i>	Lafayette County is committed to all of its children, and strives to keep each and every one of them safe; and
<i>Whereas,</i>	The Florida Child Abuse Death Review Committee's 2011 Annual Report data (from 2010) reflects that between 2004 and 2008, Florida had the 3 rd highest overall drowning death rate in the nation; and
<i>Whereas,</i>	That same report reflects that during that same time period, Florida had the highest unintentional drowning rate for children 0-4 years old; and
<i>Whereas,</i>	That same report reflects a total of 91 cases of child drowning reported statewide in 2010 (an upward trend from the previous years); and
<i>Whereas,</i>	That the practice of water safety through increased public awareness can help prevent senseless tragedies caused to children and families everywhere .

Now, therefore, through the authority vested in me by the Board of County Commissioners of Lafayette County, Florida, I do hereby proclaim July as "Water Safety Month: Promoting Water Safety Through Public Awareness" in Lafayette County, Florida.

CHANGE ORDER TO AGREEMENT TO PERFORM HOUSE PLAN RE-DESIGN SERVICES


LAFAYETTE COUNTY CDBG PROGRAM

The Agreement by and the Lafayette County Board of County Commissioners (County) and Freeman Design Group, Inc. (Designer), dated 12/6/2011, is hereby amended to add the following work:

Design of a 3-bedroom 2-bathroom house, using floorplan and comments provided by the County's grant administrator, ready for permitting under current applicable codes and regulations. The County's CDBG housing rehabilitation/replacement specifications will apply unless codes are more stringent. Three full sized, signed and sealed sets of plans will be provided to the County after the County's grant administrator approves the design. PDF versions of the documents will also be provided to the County's grant administrator for distribution to bidders and other interested parties. Site plan is not included.

Upon completion and acceptance of the plans and related documents, the County will pay the designer the sum of \$1,500.
