JUNE HURLEY RESIGNATION

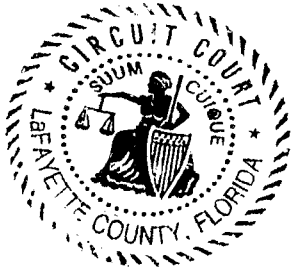
