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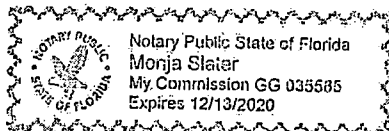

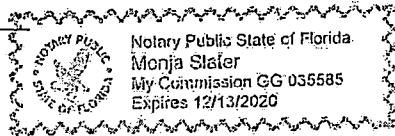

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING OVERNIGHT PRIMITIVE CAMPING IN COUNTY PARKS.

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners enacted an ordinance providing rules and regulations regarding overnight primitive camping in county parks; and

WHEREAS, the State Park system has added new park areas in Lafayette County that are available for use by the public at no charge; and

WHEREAS, the overnight primitive camping has caused unforeseen issues such as scattered garbage in County parks, damage in County parks, and non-contained bathroom waste in County parks; and

WHEREAS, due to limited resources, the County does not have sufficient staff to go behind campers and clean; and

WHEREAS, considering the current health crisis, COVID-19, it is important that we maintain sanitary county facilities to the extent possible; and

WHEREAS, due to limited resources, it is not possible to send employees to these remote areas where these parks are located in an effort enforce the rules and regulations;


IT IS THEREFORE necessary at this time to suspend all overnight primitive camping in County parks until further action by the Board of County Commissioners, and limit access to the parks from sunrise to sunset as established at sunrisesunset.com. Failure to observe these time guidelines may result in trespass charges being filed.

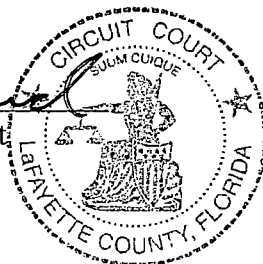
