Energy Grant

A final report and request for reimbursement was delivered to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Office of Energy on June 18, 2012.

Housing CDBG

Houses under construction, Bid Package #1:

- Robinson: work is complete except for re-painting kitchen and bathroom with enamel paint, poisoning stump, and documenting compliance with specifications.
- Smith: If weather permits, the work should be substantially complete next week.
- Hamlin: If weather permits, the work should be substantially complete next week.

Contracts to award, Bid Package #2:

Bids were received and publicly opened Friday, June 22, 2012. David Mowrey was the low bidder on all 4 houses. See the attached bid opening log, which lists all contractors who attended the pre-bid meeting. During the pre-bid meeting, bidders were told that it was unlikely that all 4 contracts would be awarded to a single bidder. On the Johnson house, Gillette Builders's bid is only \$2,277 more than Mowrey's bid.

Recommendation: Approve CDBG financing for homeowner contracts as follows:

- Doyle Adams, \$72,835 with David Mowrey,
- Teresa Davis, \$72,825 with David Mowrey,
- Robert Lawson & Linda Cowell, \$72,100 with David Mowrey,
- Donna Johnson, \$71,577 with Gillette Builders.

Recommendation: Authorize Roumelis Planning and Development Services, Inc. to approve change orders on any CDBG contract not to exceed \$1,000 per house.
