

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

REQUEST TO WAIVE INTEREST OWED ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

The Board reviewed a letter from Ruby Alcazar requesting to have her interest owed on her past due special assessments waived, and she would pay all of the special assessments owed up to date. On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve waiving the interest.

REQUEST TO SET PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITION TO CHANGE ROAD NAME

Gretchen Boyd addressed the Board in regards to a petition she filed to change the name of her road from SE C.A. Howell Drive to SE Howell Drive. The petition she filed was also signed by the other landowners who live on that road. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to set this Public Hearing for March 26, 2018 at 5:30 p.m.

ROOF AT BELL WOODWORKS SHOP AT THE INDUSTRIAL PARK

Marcus Calhoun discussed the roof at Bell Woodwork Shop at the Industrial Park, and the whether the roof should be replaced or repaired. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to make all necessary repairs needed to fix the roof, and to have Marcus write up the scope of work that needs to be done on the roof.

ROOF AT THE FOURTH DISTRICT COMMUNITY CENTER

The Board discussed the roof at the Fourth District Community Center, and the repairs needed for it. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to table this issue until the next board meeting to look at it further.

LAFAYETTE COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUCK

J.C. Lawson discussed the situation with the trucks at the Fire Department, and the possibility of purchasing a newer truck. The current truck used has engine problems and isn't reliable in an emergency situation. He found a used truck out of Seminole County that he would like the county to purchase, so that the Fire Department would have a newer truck when they are dispatched to calls. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to sole source this equipment purchase for an emergency situation. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to go ahead with the purchase of this truck, and to purchase it with funds received in the sale of the timber at the Sims Farm county owned property.

APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA TRAUMA AGENCY BOARD

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to appoint J.C. Lawson to the North Central Florida Trauma Agency Board.

OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR THE RESTRIPIING OF CR 53



The Board agreed to set up a Workshop for Tuesday, February 20, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. to discuss Economic Development in Lafayette County.

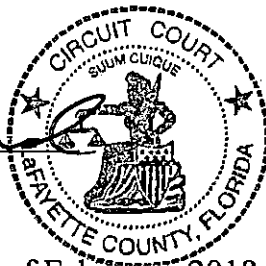
