The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

HAVEN HOSPICE HEALTHCARE PROCLAMATIONS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read the Proclamations submitted by Haven Hospice by title only. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve a Proclamation declaring April 16th, 2022 as National Healthcare Decision Day. This Proclamation was endorsed by Haven Hospice. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to declare April as National Healthcare Decisions month. This Proclamation was endorsed by Community Hospice and Palliative Care of North Central Florida.

OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR ROOFING JOB AT THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Board opened sealed bids for the partial re-roofing job at the Health Department. The only bid submitted was by Childers Roofing in the amount of \$46,000.00. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to reject the bid and to re-advertise.

APPROVE RECOMMENDATION FOR COLLECTION SITE SUB

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the recommendation of Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, and to hire Tommy Thacker as the Collection Site substitute attendant.

OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR CEMETERY MOWING AND MAINTENANCE

The Board opened sealed bids for County Cemetery mowing and maintenance. The following companies submitted bids: H&H Tractor and Site Work; Juarbe Services, LLC; Brian Pittman; T3 Lawncare; Elmer Bell; and Quality Lawns & More, LLC. After reviewing the sealed bids, which had the cemeteries broken down into 5 different groups, and on a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to award the bids on each group the following way: Group 1 – Quality Lawns & More, LLC; Group 2 – Brian Pittman; Group 3 – Quality Lawns & More, LLC; Group 4 – Brian Pittman; and Group 5 – Elmer Bell. Courthouse Renovation Construction Fund - \$68,835.10


DISCUSS POSSIBLE GRANT TO FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

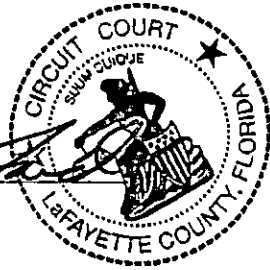





National Healthcare Decision Day is recognized across our nation on April 16, 2022 to raise public awareness of the need to plan ahead for health-care decisions, especially those related to end of life care and medical decision-making when patients are unable to speak for themselves, and to encourage the specific use of advanced directives to communicate these important health care decisions.


Many Lafayette County, Florida residents have not yet prepared for health-care decisions in times of crisis or at end of life, nor had important conversations with their families and their healthcare with their families and documented those decisions.

It is likely a significant reason for these low percentages is that there is both a lack of awareness and an uncertainty in the public about Advanced Directives.

One of the goals of Healthcare Decisions Day is to raise awareness and provide clear and consistent information to the public about advanced directives, as well as to encourage medical professionals and lawyers to volunteer their time and efforts to improve public knowledge and increase the number of citizens with advanced directives.

Haven Hospice endorses this event and is committed to educating the public during the month of April to stress the importance of discussing health care choices and executing advance directive to make their wishes know.

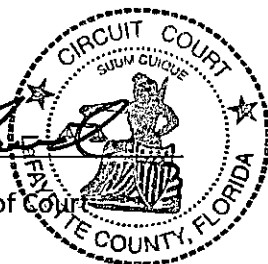

National Healthcare Decisions Day Proclamation

WHEREAS: National Healthcare Decisions Day is recognized across the country on April 16th, it is designed to inspire, educate, and empower the public and providers about the importance of advance care planning; to raise public awareness of the need to plan for health-care decisions, especially those related to end-of-life care and medical decision-making when patients are unable to speak for themselves; and to encourage the specific use of advance directives to communicate these important health care decisions; and

WHEREAS: health care and community organizations across Florida state are assisting people to plan for future health care decisions in the event they are unable to make their own medical decisions and to encourage the use of advance directives to communicate these important health care decisions; and

WHEREAS: a large percentage of Lafayette County residents have not yet prepared for healthcare decisions; in times of crisis and/or at end of life had not had important conversations with their families, loved ones, and their healthcare providers and documented those decisions; and

WHEREAS: it is likely that a significant reason for this large percentage is that there is both a lack of knowledge and considerable confusion in the public about advance care planning and advance directives; and

WHEREAS: one of the principal goals of National Healthcare Decisions Day is to encourage physicians and their care teams, medical groups, hospitals and health systems, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, continuing care retirement communities, hospices and community organizations to participate in a statewide effort to provide clear and consistent information to the public about advance care planning; and

WHEREAS: Community Hospice and Palliative Care of North Central Florida and other health care organizations and community groups have endorsed this event and are committed to educating the public about the importance of discussing health care choices and executing advance directives; and


WHEREAS: The COVID-19 pandemic makes advance care planning even more important with every age group being impacted and 840,000 deaths and counting in the United States attributed to the virus.

WHEREAS: as a result of the month of April 2022 being recognized as "National Healthcare Decisions Month" and April 16th, 2022, as "National Healthcare Decisions Day", more citizens will have conversations about their health care decisions; more citizens will execute advance directives to make their wishes known; and fewer families and health care providers will have to struggle with making difficult health care decisions in the absence of guidance from the patient;
