The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR A DOUBLEWIDE PORTABLE CLASSROOM

The Board opened the following sealed bids for a doublewide portable classroom located at the Extension Office: Dixie Fix, LLC – bid amount \$500.00; and Lafayette Baseball Boosters – bid amount \$750.00. Industrial Park Fund - \$299.63


Special Account Grants Fund - \$35,536.72

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

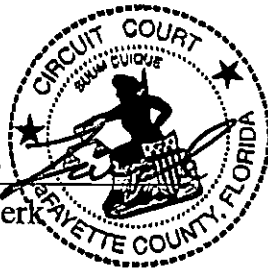
