Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

GARBAGE TRUCK OPERATOR POSITION

Mr. Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, recommended that the Board hire John Wood to fill the position of Garbage Truck Operator. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the recommendation, and to give Mr. Sadler the authorization to re-advertise the position again if it falls through.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

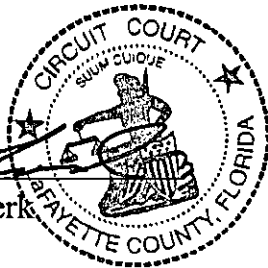
