#### APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

### WALLACE SCRAP METAL REQUEST

Mike Wallace, with Wallace Scrap Metal requested permission from the Board to close off half of their restroom for their business and leave the other half open to the public. #### SE LAND ROAD PROJECT

#### NE GOLDDUST ROAD PROJECT

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to proceed with the NE Golddust Road improvement project. Scott Sadler is trying to acquire permission from the Florida Department of Transportation before proceeding. If he doesn't get any response, then the Board wants it brought back before them.

Dear Board of County Commissioners:

Florida Administrative Code 27P-19.01, states the following concerning match requirements required for the annual EMPA Grant received by the county.

Base Grants shall be matched at an amount either equal to the average of the previous three years' level of county general revenue funding of the County Emergency Management Agency or the level of funding for the County Emergency Management Agency for the last fiscal year, whichever figure is lower. County general revenue funding for 911 services, emergency medical services, law enforcement, criminal justice, public works or other services outside the emergency management responsibilities assigned to the County Emergency Management Agency by Section 252.38, F.S., shall not be included in determining the "level of county funding of the County Emergency Management Agency." Each county shall certify compliance with this rule chapter and this rule, as a condition precedent to receipt of funding.

Currently the lowest figure is the average of the previous three years, which is \$33,961.68.

I would like to respectfully request that the matching funds of \$33,961.68 be approved and budgeted to the Lafayette County Sheriff's Office Emergency Management budget. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
