The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

MARTY TOMPKINS – LAFAYETTE COUNTY EMS

Mr. Marty Tompkins, with Lafayette County EMS, discussed with the Board some issues that EMS has been having with local nursing homes in the area. They have been getting non-transport calls from the facilities to do things that, in Mr. Tompkins' opinion, their staff should do and EMS shouldn't be contacted for non-emergency calls. The Board told Mr. Tompkins to contact the Executive Director of the facilities and explain the role and duties of EMS before reporting back to the Board for any action to be taken.

PUBLIC HEARING – RESOLUTION NO. 2018-01-01

SET A PUBLIC HEARING DATE ON A PETITION TO CHANGE THE NAME OF A ROAD


