REQUEST FROM TRAVIS HART



RESOLUTION NO. V13-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SERVING AS THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA GRANTING A VARIANCE AS AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION 3.2.5 OF THE LAFAYETTE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR A VARIANCE TO ALLOW A **REDUCTION OF THE WEST AND EAST SIDE YARD SETBACK FROM 50 FEET TO 10 FEET** WITHIN AN AGRICULTURAL-3 (AG-3) ZONING DISTRICT AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 4.5.7 OF CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR REVOCATION OF THE VARIANCE; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Lafayette County Land Development Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Land Development Regulations, empowers the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, to grant or deny variances as authorized under Section 3.2.5 of the Land Development Regulations;

WHEREAS, a petition for a variance as described below has been filed with the County;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Land Development Regulations, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, held the required public notice having been provided, on said petition for a variance, as described below, and considered all comments received during said public hearing and the Concurrency Management Assessment concerning said petition for a variance, as described below;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, has found that they are empowered under Section 3.2.5 of the Land Development Regulations to grant or deny a variance, as described below;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, has determined and found that the granting of said petition for a variance, as described below, would promote the public prosperity or general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, has determined and found that:

- (a) special conditions and circumstances exist which are peculiar to the land, structure, or building involved and which are not applicable to other lands, structures, or buildings in the same zoning district;
- (b) such special conditions and circumstances do not result from the actions of the applicant;
- (c) granting the variance requested will not confer on the applicant a special privilege that is denied by the land development regulations to other lands, buildings or structures in the same zoning district;
- (d) literal interpretation of the provisions of the land development regulations would deprive the applicant of rights commonly enjoyed by other properties in the same zoning district under the terms of the land development regulations and would work unnecessary and undue hardship on the applicant;

- (e) the variance granted is the minimum variance that will make possible the reasonable use of the land, building or structure; and
- (f) granting of the variance will be in harmony with the general intent and purpose of the land development regulations, and such variance will not be injurious to the area involved or otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SERVING AS THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS OF LAFAYETTE, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to a petition, V13-001, by Ryan Sullivan, President of White Oak Dairy, Inc., and Agent for Randall Lebolo, requesting a Variance be granted to the requirements of the Land Development Regulations the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustments of Lafayette County, Florida, hereby grants a variance to allow **reduction of west and east side yard setback from 50 to 10 feet** within the AGRICULTURAL-3 (AG-3) ZONING DISTRICT

Property described as follows: LEG 0001.00 ACRES LOT 12 BUCK COUNTRY SUBDIVISION PB A P. 96 PUBLIC RECORDS LAFAYETTE CO. FL. OR BK 217 P 85

Last week the Lafayette County Commission received notice that the worksquads that we receive from the Mayo Correctional Institution will be reduced. Please find attached a letter from our Public Works Director that outlines the value those squads are to our citizens. Our local government could not completely replace those services because of financial hardship.

I would like to take this time to remind you of the commitment made by the Department of Corrections to the Lafayette County Commission in 2006 for the \$480,000 donation made by the county. The County Commission sold county property to receive funds to purchase the property where the Mayo Correction Facility Annex exists now. The purpose was to add jobs and make additional worksquads available to the county. Neither has happened after the old prison was moved to the Annex.

Please consider the above information as you consider the budget cuts. If there is any way that Lafayette County could be "held harmless" it would be greatly appreciated.

Work Squads in Lafayette County

The Lafayette County Public works department retains three work squads that are vital to performing all the services that the public works department offers. These services include, but are not limited to the following:

Squad 1 – Mowing and maintenance of 27 cemeteries in Lafayette County as in acted by house bill 2866 in 1969. This squad also maintains and mows county properties such as the sheriff's office, public library, 4 community centers, EMS station, and fire stations. The county has spent over \$12,680 in the past two years updating and buying new equipment for this squad to perform these valuable tasks. For the county to assign these tasks to county personal it would cost the county an estimated \$88,084.00 in new personal and equipment per year.

Squad 2 – Performs a variety of jobs for Public works. They man a chipping crew that maintains our 126 miles of paved road right of way. As county personal trims the trees from the right of way squad 2 saws and chips the limbs along with clearing any debris form the road way. This squad also cleans county boat ramps and parks along the Suwannee River which is a vital part of eco tourism for the county. They also trim around road signs, culverts, and curves on our 286 miles of dirt roads in the county. Along with all these task this crew also picks up trash from the road right of ways and has helped on countless construction projects in the county. The estimated cost of performing these tasks with county personal would be \$101,584.00.

Squad 3 – This squad is vital to the solid waste and recycling efforts of Lafayette County. This squad helps with sorting and baling of plastics, cardboard, aluminum cans, and glass. They also serve to clean and haul off furniture and debris from our 5 collection sites across the county. The 3rd squad cleans and helps maintain the county recreational complex as well as the industrial park. To replace this squad with county personal would be an estimated cost of \$111,091.20 per year.

In conclusion in a small rural county such as ours where we only employee 13 full time and 3 part time people for the Public Works department, these 3 work squads are vital. The estimated cost to replace these squads would be estimated at \$300,759.20 per year. To lose any of these squads would be devastating to our budget and the service given to our county residents.
