The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

**APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**AGRI-METAL SUPPLY, INC. PROJECT**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve an invoice to Mike Gleaton for electrical work that was done as part of the work on the Agri-metal Supply job at the Industrial Park.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to authorize Moran Insulation to complete the original area discussed at the Agri-Metal Supply building, as long as they will do the job at the unit price that was bid.

**LAFAYETTE COUNTY EMS**

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to authorize Marty Tompkins, EMS Director, to hire a part-time paramedic to replace a current paramedic who is out for 2-3 months with an injury.

**AUTHORIZE MR. HAMLIN TO SIGN LETTERS OF SUPPORT**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to authorize Mr. Donnie Hamlin, as Board Chairman, to sign letters of support to the Legislature on springs restoration and water supply for the Suwannee River Water Management District.

**ANIMAL HEALTH LEASE AT THE INDUSTRIAL PARK**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to renew the lease with Animal Health, which is now Patterson Companies, for 5 years.

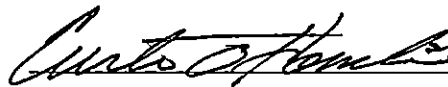
**APPROVE THE BILLS**
