The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

SET BACK ORDINANCE VIOLATION

Mr. Sonny May and others from his neighborhood, addressed the Board with their concerns regarding one of his neighbors, Mr. Burton Lawson, who has calf pens on his property which are on the boundary line and violates the set back ordinance. After discussion, on a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to have Mr. Bobby Johnson send Mr. Lawson a certified letter informing him of the violation of the ordinance.

PRESENTATION CONCERNING RURAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Mrs. Diane Scholz, with the Florida State Institute of Government Rural and Economic Development Services requested that the Board sign a Memorandum of Agreement to amend the Rural and Economic Development Services. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve signing the Agreement.

DEBBIE BELCHER – CDBG GRANT AND ENERGY GRANT

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Lamb, with Mr. Hamlin abstaining for conflict of interest, the Board voted unanimously to approve the CDBG and SHIP assistance to Terrell and Myrtle Hamlin according to the County's CDBG policy, and to authorize Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson to request that the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity issue a waiver of the conflict of interest between Commissioner Hamlin and the Hamlin households.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve a change order request for Harlie Lynch Construction to purchase new recessed lights for the Day Community Center, the ones that were purchased did not work. The Board also chose the colors for the flooring to be installed in the Community Centers.

REQUEST FOR FENCING AROUND GENERATOR FOR THE TOWN OF MAYO

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve for fencing around the generator at the lift stations for the Town of Mayo.

REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF PART TIME EMT

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve a request to hire Jason Ashton as a part time EMT pending a background check on him.

TREVOR HICKS – LAFAYETTE COUNTY EMS

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Trevor Hicks purchasing new shirts for EMS and to have A3 Graphics do the lettering on them. Mr. Hicks said that new mattresses need to be purchased for the station also and that the duct work needs to be cleaned out at the station. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve purchasing the new mattresses and to get quotes to clean out the duct work, but to approve using the low bidder to do the work.

DECLARE APRIL 2012 AS WATER CONSERVATION MONTH

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to declare April 2012 as Water Conservation Month.

WILDFLOWERS RESOLUTION

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution No. 2012-2-1-3 regarding the management of wildflowers on State Roads and Highways in Lafayette County.

PUBLIC HEARING – ROAD CLOSING PETITIONS

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve a Road Closing Petition by Charles Driver. The Resolution number is 2012-2-1-1.

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve a Road Closing Petition by Frank Page. The Resolution number is 2012-2-1-2.

PROPOSALS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE EZELL AND HURST BOAT RAMPS

The Board reviewed the proposal turned in for the Engineering Services for the Ezell and Hurst Boat Ramps and filled out the ranking sheet after review. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, with Mrs. Garrard abstaining for conflict, the Board voted unanimously to accept and approve the proposal from Southeastern Consulting Engineering Services.

INDIGENT BURIAL REQUEST

The Board considered an indigent burial request for Tex Keen. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted to table this issue until they can get more information on this.

1977 MACK SEMI TRUCK

The Board discussed the 1977 Mack Semi Truck that was declared as surplus and advertised to receive bids to purchase the truck. No bids were turned in and on a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to have Mr. Scott Sadler sell the truck for salvage.

JANUARY BUILDING DEPARTMENT/SOLID WASTE REPORTS

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the January Building Department and Solid Waste monthly reports.

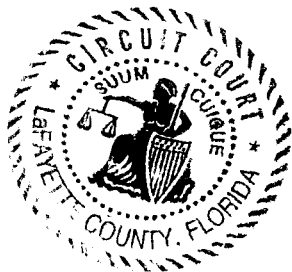





WHEREAS, in the spring of 1513, Juan Ponce de Leon named this beautiful place La Florida, Land of Flowers, because of the wealth of native wildflowers; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2013, native wildflowers will be a prominent icon of Florida's and Lalonde County's quincentennial celebration of Spain in Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and attainable to experience the beauty of many more native wildflowers by reducing the frequency and extent of roadside mowing; and

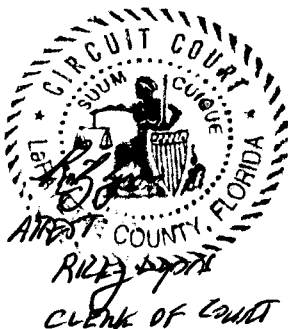
WHEREAS, State Road 51, 349 Highway; and County Road 53, _____ Road are ideal candidates to establish pilot project corridors for management of native wildflowers;
