

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

#### **APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

#### **THALIA ROAD CALF RAISING OPERATION**

Mr. Sonny May addressed the Board with regard to and as a follow-up from a discussion held at the last County Commissioner's meeting on a calf raising operation located on Thalia Road and owned by Burton Lawson. Mr. May advised that he and the other property owners near the calf raising operation want the county's set back ordinance 4.5.2 enforced on all sides of Mr. Burton's property. Mr. Bobby Johnson advised that he sent a letter to Mr. Lawson on February 15, 2012 regarding compliance on the north side of the property and that Mr. Lawson had 30 days to comply.

#### **PRESENTATION BY SUWANNEE RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT**

Mr. Charlie Houder, acting Director, Mr. John Dinges, and Mrs. Melanie Roberts with Suwannee River Water Management District, made a presentation before the Board regarding our water supply. The public was informed that a meeting will be held on March 7, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. in Alachua at City Hall. No action was taken on this issue.

#### **DEBBIE BELCHER – ENERGY EFFICIENT/CDBG GRANT**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the pay request for Harlie Lynch Construction in the amount of \$132,815.39 for the Energy Grant.

Mrs. Belcher discussed the sealed bids that were opened last week for the CDBG Grant homes. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve SHIP and CDBG funding for Joyce Smith to contract with Bryan-Co Construction Services, Inc. for home replacement, including deferred payment loan closing costs. Funds will include \$50,000 in SHIP funds and the balance in CDBG funds.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with Mr. Hamlin abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve SHIP and CDBG funding for Terrell and Myrtle Hamlin to contract with Bryan-Co Construction Services, Inc. for home replacement, including deferred payment loan closing costs. Funds will include \$50,000 in SHIP funds and the balance in CDBG funds. Notice to proceed must be delayed until receiving state approval due to the conflict on interest with Commissioner Hamlin.

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve SHIP and CDBG funding for Lavonia Robinson and Martha Robinson to contract with Fla. Homes, Inc. for home rehabilitation, including deferred payment loan closing costs. Funds will include \$30,000 in SHIP funds and the balance in CDBG funds.

None of the Commissioners expressed a conflict with the two low bidding contractors for this job, Bryan-Co. Construction Services, Inc. or Fla. Homes, Inc.

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve that all construction be homes instead of mobile homes since the bids are so close and that site built homes will last longer and have more long term taxable value.

#### **STEINHATCHEE SPRINGS BRIDGE**

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve repairing the Steinhatchee Springs Bridge.

#### **CHECK FOR A+ TRAILERS AND FABRICATION, INC.**

Mr. Donnie Hamlin discussed past due rent for A+ Trailers and Fabrication, Inc., a tenant at the Lafayette County Industrial Park. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to hold the check on the warrant list for A+ Trailers and Fabrication, Inc. until the payment of their rent is up to date.

#### **CONTRACT WITH SOUTHEASTERN CONSULTING ENGINEERS**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the contract with Southeastern Consulting Engineers for the Hurst and Ezell Boat Ramps.

**SPECIAL ASSESSMENT EXEMPTION REQUESTS**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Special Assessment exemption requests that are under the guideline. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to deny the requests that exceed the guideline.

**PUBLIC HEARING – SPEED LIMIT ON JIM LAND ROAD**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read a proposed ordinance to lower the speed limit on Jim Land Road by title only. After discussion, on a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to table the proposed ordinance.

**PUBLIC HEARING – CHURCH SPEED ZONES**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read a proposed ordinance to lower the speed limit in church zones on county roads. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Ordinance.

**REPORT BY COUNTY FORESTER ON TIMBER AT SIMS FARM**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to continue a presentation to be given by the County Forester on timber at the Sims Farm.

**INDIGENT BURIAL REQUEST**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to deny the Indigent Burial request that was discussed at the last meeting because the deceased was not a resident of Lafayette County.

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

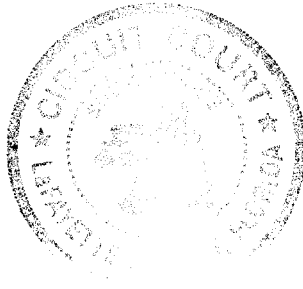
**DECLARE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS**



ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 02

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AREAS RECOGNIZED AS CHURCH ZONES AND IMPLEMENTING A SPEED LIMIT OF 15 MPH IN SAID ZONES. REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Lafayette County, Florida:

**SECTION 1:** This ordinance hereby creates an area known as a church zone.

**SECTION 2:** Said church zone shall be that section of county road, depending on location, that provides access to any church located in Lafayette County, Florida.

**SECTION 3:** Said section of roadway shall have a measurement of between 100 and 150 yards in length depending on the specific needs of the church and the church grounds.

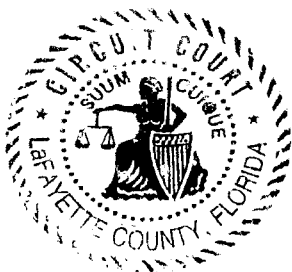
**SECTION 4:** Said zones are being created to promote and provide a safe environment for individuals crossing the road or participating in functions being held in church zones.

**SECTION 5:** Any church located in Lafayette County may request that a church zone be established. Upon request, the Board of County Commissioners will consider the request and establish the church zone through passage of a Resolution. Individual churches shall purchase all signage and materials necessary for enforcement of and pursuant to this ordinance.


**SECTION 6:** All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 7:** This ordinance shall take effect upon the date signed and as prescribed in Florida Statute 125.66.

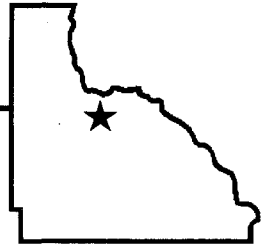

The fences you installed on the north property line on the above mentioned parcel are a violation of the Land Development Regulations adopted by Ordinance 2000-5, with an effective date of July 1, 2000.

The above mentioned parcel is zoned Agricultural-3 (A-3) with a density of one dwelling per five acres. Section 4.5.2 for A-3 district allows for the raising of livestock but states that "no structure used for housing of livestock or any commercial feed lot operation shall be located within one hundred (100) feet of any lot line".

Upon receiving this letter your property must be brought into compliance of the Land Development Regulations within thirty (30) days, **or you may** enter a written appeal within thirty (30) days following the date of this notice to the Board of Adjustment of Lafayette County (P O Box 88, Mayo, Florida 32066) and file the same in writing with the Land Development Regulation Administrator (P O Box 28 Mayo, Florida 32066) as per Section 12.1.3.

A "business associate" means any person or entity engaged in or carrying on a business enterprise with the officer as a partner, joint venturer, coowner of property, or corporate shareholder (where the shares of the corporation are not listed on any national or regional stock exchange).

Although you must abstain from voting in the situations described above, you otherwise may participate in these matters. However, you must disclose the nature of the conflict before making any attempt to influence the decision, whether orally or in writing and whether made by you or at your direction.
