The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

REQUEST TO PURCHASE TWO RADIOS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Marty Tompkins asked for approval from the Board to purchase two VHF mobile radios for the Fire Department, one to replace one that is inoperable, and one for the new fire truck that was recently purchased. On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the purchase of the radios.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03-01

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read Resolution No. 2018-03-01 by title only. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the resolution declaring April as Water Conservation Month.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT EXEMPTION REQUESTS FOR 2017-2018

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to keep the rate for Special Assessment Exemption requests the same as in previous years - \$9,500 for single, and \$11,500 for family households. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve all on the list that qualified for exemption based on the guidelines.



WHEREAS, Lafayette County has always encouraged and supported water conservation, through various educational programs and special events; and


WHEREAS, every business, industry, school and citizen can make a difference when it comes to conserving water; and
