The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT LIEN EXEMPTION REQUEST

Mrs. Coleta Mathis received a Special Assessment Lien and requested exemption of the interest on her lien amount. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve Mrs. Mathis paying the lien amount and waive the interest fee to clear up the lien on her property.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT EXEMPTION REQUEST

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve waiving the interest owed on special assessments for Eddie Wheeler, and he can pay the past due amount only.

REQUEST TO USE THE COMMUNITY CENTER AT NO CHARGE

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to allow Eisman & Russo to use the Mayo Community Center at no charge for a construction contractor meeting.

COMMUNITY CENTER BOOKING POLICY

The Board discussed implementing a policy similar to the Library's meeting room policy, when scheduling for individuals or organizations to use the Community Center. On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the policy used at the Library for people who want to rent the community center for consecutive weeks, it can be booked for three consecutive times and then they would need to call again to rent for another three weeks, if the community center is available.

The Board also agreed to allow the Girl Scouts to use the Mayo Community Center on Thursdays from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. every week at no charge.

AGREEMENT WITH DISASTERS, STRATEGIES AND IDEAS GROUP

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to formally authorize the execution of the agreement with the Disasters, Strategies and Ideas Group for Emergency Management.

PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT CAMERAS AT THE JAIL

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to use carry over funds from the Sheriff's Office budget to purchase replacement cameras at the Jail.

PUBLIC HEARING – SPECIAL ASSESSMENT EXEMPTION REQUESTS

The Board held a public hearing to review the list of requests for exemption from special assessments. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to set the annual income amounts for exemption at \$9,500.00 annually for single and \$11,000.00 annually for family.

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to exempt all on the list that meet the income requirements previously voted on.

REQUEST TO USE FOURTH DISTRICT COMMUNITY CENTER AT NO CHARGE

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Hatchbend Apostolic Food Ministry using the Fourth District Community Center on the third Thursday of the month for distribution at no charge.
