Industrial Park Fund - \$9,216.14



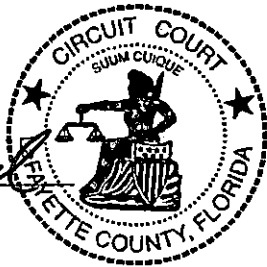



county-maintained road is not formally named; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for emergency and non-emergency purposes that said county-
