REGULAR MEETING JULY 25, 2016 5:30 P.M.

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS MEETING

The Board of Adjustments held a public hearing to consider a petition by Chris and Kelly Lyons, as agent for Carl Wainwright, to build poultry houses. The parcel of land is described as follows:

discussion was held, on a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to table this issue until a later meeting for the Board to further review all of the information that they were given. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to set this for a special meeting on Wednesday, July 27, 2016 at 12:00 p.m.
