The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

**APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**THREE RIVERS REGIONAL LIBRARY UPDATE**

Dale Collum, with the Three Rivers Regional Library, gave the Board an update on services provided by them to the county. No action was taken on this issue, update only.

**FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

Barney Bennett, with the Florida Department of Transportation, discussed the County work plan with the Board. No action was taken on this issue.

**FLORIDA FORESTRY SERVICE**

Jarrold Beauchamp, with the Florida Forestry Service, gave the Board the annual Florida Forestry Service report. No action was taken on this issue.

**REPAIR WORK AT THE INDUSTRIAL PARK**

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve Marcus Calhoun to begin the repair work that needs to be done at the Industrial Park to restructure the electrical service coming in to the building at the old Wallace Scrap Metal location.

**POWER LINE AT NE RIVERSIDE BLVD.**

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Road Department clearing trees/limbs along the county right-of-way on NE Riverside Blvd, for Suwannee Valley Electric Cooperative to put up a power line.

**MONROE AVENUE PROJECT**

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve assigning the Monroe Avenue Project to Darabi & Associates, Inc. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to table assigning an engineering firm for the CEI part of this project until the plans are complete.

**MERIDIAN MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Meridian Mental Health Services contract.

**PROPERTY MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE**

On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve advertising the Property Management Ordinance for approval.

**ADVERTISE TO RECEIVE RFQ'S FOR THE CDBG GRANT**





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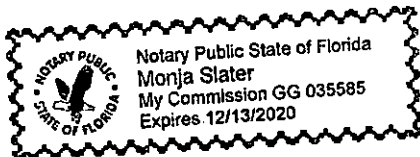

## LAFAYETTE COUNTY

FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH  
AND ADDICTION SERVICES

**THIS AGREEMENT** entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2017, by and between the **Board of County Commissioners of Lafayette County**, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," and **Meridian Behavioral Healthcare, Inc.**, an independent contractor, hereinafter referred to as "MBH".

For and in consideration of the mutual undertaking and agreements hereinafter set forth, the Commission and MBH agree as follows:

1. The Commission Agrees:

A. To provide funds to MBH consistent with the requirements of Florida Statute (§394.76) for the provision of general mental health, and substance use services, including Baker Act services to the citizens of Lafayette County in the amount of \$16,29300. This sum is for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2017, and ending September 30, 2018, and the Commission's allocation to operate the program and facilities for services for citizens of Lafayette County.

B. To release such funds in the amount of \$4,073.25 per quarter, upon receipt of an invoice due on the first day of each quarter.

2. MBH Agrees:

A. To provide mental health and substance use services, including Baker Act services to the citizens of Lafayette County.

B. To provide services to any person and ensure that no service will be denied and/or delayed to any person because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age or ability to pay.

C. To ensure that all information regarding clients be safeguarded in accordance with 45 C.F.R. § 205.50. 42 C.F.R..

D. To comply with the provisions contained in the Civil Rights certificate.

E. To provide, monitor, evaluate, and audit all programs funded under the terms of this agreement according to Federal and C&F guidelines, rules, regulations, instructions, and the approved C&F Plan.

F. Any funds expended in violation of this agreement or in violation of appropriate Federal and State requirements, or any funds claimed by MBH which are determined by the Commission to be in violation of appropriate departmental or federal guidelines shall be

refunded in full to the Commission or if this agreement is still in force, shall be withheld by the Commission from any subsequent compensation request.

G. To retain all fiscal and client books, records, or other documents relative to this agreement for seven (7) years after final payments or until audit or resolution of audit findings by county auditors.

H. To provide an opportunity for recipients of services to present their views about the service program and also establish a system through which clients may present reasonable grievances about the delivery of services under this agreement. Such system shall include provision for fair hearing.

I. To negotiate sub-agreements and be responsible for the execution of sub-agreements pursuant to this agreement. Such sub-agreements may be reviewed by the Commission and if they are found not to be in compliance with the provisions of this agreement, they shall be subject to revision by MBH, or funds may be withheld by the Commission.

3. MBH and the Commission Mutually Agree:

A. This agreement shall begin on October 1, 2017, 12:01 a.m. and end on September 30, 2018, at midnight.

B. This agreement, or any part of this agreement, may be terminated with or without cause, by either party, at any time, upon no less than thirty (30) days notice in writing to the other party. Said notice shall be delivered by certified mail, telegram or in person.

C. Any alterations, variation, modification and/or waivers of provisions of this agreement shall be valid only when they have been reduced to writing, duly signed by all parties to the agreement, and attached to the original agreement.

D. This agreement contains all terms and conditions agreed upon by the parties. No other agreements, oral or otherwise regarding the subject matter of this agreement shall be deemed to exist or to bind any of the parties hereto.
