The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

BIDS FOR ELECTRICAL DROPS AT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Mr. Donnie Land gave the Board two bids for electrical drops to be installed at the Fire Department. The bids were as follows: Santa Fe Electric - \$2,600.00 and Gleaton Electric - \$1,350.00. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to go with Gleaton Electric as the low bidder.

DEBBIE BELCHER – CDBG GRANT

Mrs. Belcher submitted a list of contractors to the Board for House Plan designs for the CDBG Grant. The following contractors submitted bids: Freeman Design Group, GTC Design Group, and Tri-County Home Designs. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve Freeman Design Group, as the recommendation of Mrs. Belcher. Mrs. Belcher also gave the Board a list of applicants for the CDBG Grant who have been approved, those rejected and those for further review. Mr. Jones requested to go with Mr. Cecil Westbrook and inspect some of the applicants' current residences to review them on a case by case basis to see which ones will be approved for a home. Mrs. Belcher said that she would take the list to the Citizens Advisory Task Force for review and then present the list to the Board for final approval at the meeting on December 12, 2011.

DEBBIE BELCHER – ENERGY GRANT

Mrs. Belcher told the Board that she will have bids ready to be opened and awarded for the Energy Grant at the Board meeting on December 27, 2011 at 12:00 p.m. She said she will have the deadline for the bids be due the week before so that she can review them and they will be ready for the Board to award the bid on December 27.

COLLECTION OF PAST DUE DUMPSTER BILLS

The Board requested that Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson draft a form letter for use by the Building Department on their letterhead for collection purposes on past due accounts. This was the general consent of the Board.

OCTOBER BUILDING DEPARTMENT/SOLID WASTE REPORTS

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the October Building Department and Solid Waste reports.

PROPOSAL FOR 911 DISPATCH EQUIPMENT FOR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal from Williams Communications, Inc. for 911 Dispatch which includes radios and computers for the new 911 Dispatch Center, as presented by the Sheriff's Department. The GSA Contract number for the equipment is GS-35F0086S.

SIGNS WARNING FIREFIGHTERS OF WOOD ROOFS IN COUNTY BUILDINGS

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have 9x9 signs installed on all county buildings warning the Firefighters of what kind of wood the roof is made out of. The cost will be \$25.00 each for a total of 25 signs.

ADVERTISING ROAD CLOSING PETITION FOR PORTION OF NW ELIZA CLARK ROAD

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve advertising a road closing petition to close a portion of NW Eliza Clark Road that was done by White Oak Dairy.

SPEED LIMIT SIGNS FOR DRIVING BY CHURCHES

Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson discussed having speed limit signs put up to lower the speed limit when driving by all churches in the county with the Board. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson look in to what needs to be done to do this and get the information to the Board at a later meeting.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, with the exception of the B's Starters & Alternators bill, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

- General Fund - \$318,375.51
- Emergency 911 Fund - \$5,048.25
- Courthouse Renovation Reserve Fund - \$78,519.65
- Capital Projects Fund - \$397.07

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with Mr. Byrd abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the B's Starters & Alternators bill in the amount of \$50.00.

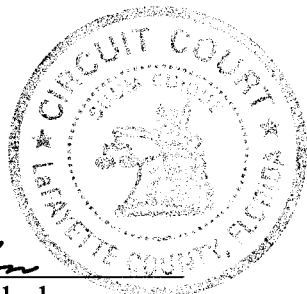
