

REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 10, 2014
9:00 A.M.

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

PEGGY GRILL – PADDLE FOR AUTISM EVENT

Mrs. Peggy Grill discussed the 3rd Annual Suwannee River Paddle for Autism on April 26, 2014. She is requesting that the Board participate in and be a sponsor for this event. No action was taken on this issue.

RESOLUTION ON EZELL BOAT RAMP

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution from Mr. Jack Husband on the Ezell Boat Ramp construction.

SUWANNEE RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Mr. Eric Marzloff, with the Suwannee River Water Management District, asked permission from the Board to put up a memorial in memory of a former district employee, Broughton Land at the Dorothy Land boat ramp in Hatchbend. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve their request.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT EXEMPTION REQUESTS

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Special Assessment exemption requests that are in the previously approve guideline. The amounts set were \$9,500 for single and \$11,000 for multi household.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR HELI-PAD

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Interlocal Agreement with the Lafayette County School Board for the heli-pad for EMS.

DAY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Board discussed the closing on the Day Volunteer Fire Department property. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Chairman Lamb to check on a few things and report back to them at the next meeting.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-03-01-01 (CULVERTS)

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve Resolution No. 2014-03-01-01 pending changes being made by Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson. This Resolution is in reference to driveway permits and the installation and maintenance of culverts.

OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR MOWERS AND LINE TRIMMERS

The Board opened sealed bids from Pridgeon's Garage; John's Lawn Equipment and Gordon Tractor, Inc. for mowers and line trimmers. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to go with the recommendation of Mr. Scott Sadler after he reviews the bids and makes a recommendation.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with the exception of the Paul Lamb bill, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

General Fund - \$346,539.43
Emergency 911 Fund - \$29,373.36
Industrial Park Fund - \$88.26

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Jones, with Mr. Lamb abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Paul Lamb bill in the amount of \$409.00.

LANTANA ROAD PROJECT BID OPENING

No bids were received for the Lantana Road Project. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to re-advertise the project for bids.

ADJOURN TO ATTEND STANLEY CANNON DEDICATION CEREMONY

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting to attend the dedication ceremony in honor of Stanley Cannon in Cooks Hammock at 11:30 a.m.

RESOLUTION—DRIVEWAY PERMITS
2014-03-01-01

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to have a consistent policy as it relates to installing and maintaining culverts in the County, it is hereby Resolved as follows:

1. At the request of a landowner, the County may install a driveway, to include a culvert, if necessary, at the landowner's request.
2. Prior to installation, landowner must apply for a driveway permit through the building department. Said permit is \$25.00. Permit fee may be amended by the County Commission by resolution.
3. Upon application, the building department will notify the public works department of the application. The public works department will inspect the property as it relates to the installation of a driveway,(to include a culvert, if necessary). The public works representative will make the determination as to whether culvert installation is necessary.
4. In the event the public works department determines that a culvert is necessary, landowner may purchase the culvert from the County at cost and the County will install the culvert. The Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the County that the public works department install the culvert due to the fact that the County will be maintaining the culvert in the public right of way and it is necessary that the culvert be installed correctly and properly.
5. Culverts installed by the County under this resolution will be maintained by the County.
6. No culverts will be installed without application by and permit fee paid by the landowner.
7. All previous policies and or rules with regard to culvert installation and maintenance are hereby repealed.

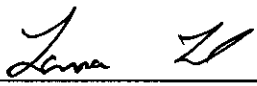
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the County to apply for the grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE,

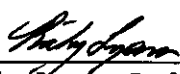

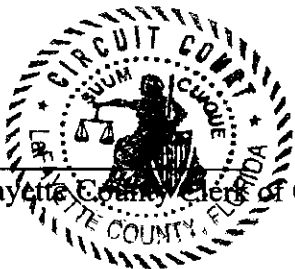

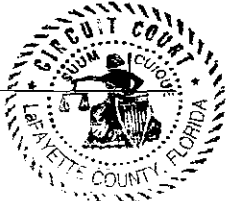
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
HELIPAD

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 18 day of MARCH, 2014 between the Lafayette County School Board and the Lafayette County Board of County Commissioners and the parties agree as follows:

1. The County has need of an appropriate space to utilize as a landing area for emergency aircraft in emergency health situations in the central part of Lafayette County.
2. The School Board has discussed the issue and understands the need for such an area.
3. Based on discussions between the parties, the County may utilize a small parcel of land located in the northwest portion of the current school board property.
4. Said utilization shall be used as a helipad (landing zone) for emergency aircraft regarding emergency medical situations in the County.
5. The County shall cover all costs to install the helipad and any expenses associated with maintenance of the helipad and the immediate surrounding area.
6. In the event there is a school or community function being held near the helipad area, then in that event the helipad shall not be used by the County at that time. The County has made plans for such a situation, and an alternative landing zone shall be utilized by the County under these circumstances.
7. The emergency aircraft company/vendor carries liability insurance that covers the County in the event of an accident. The School Board will be added as an insured to said coverage.
8. In the event, and at any time in the future that the School would need the subject parcel/area for any purpose, upon request of the School Board, County shall discontinue use of the helipad area as soon as practically possible, but in no event more than 30 days from the date of notice.
9. County shall hold harmless the School Board against any and all claims associated with use of the helipad by the County and its personnel and any emergency aircraft and its personnel working in conjunction with the County EMS.
10. Both the County and the School Board are represented by McMillan Law Office PA/Leenette W. McMillan-Fredriksson, Attorney. Both parties have requested that McMillan-Fredriksson prepare this agreement. Both parties are aware that McMillan-Fredriksson represents the other party. Both parties have agreed to waive the conflict associated with McMillan-Fredriksson preparing the agreement for both parties. Both parties agree that the agreement has been drawn in the manner prescribed and approved by both parties.
11. All terms of the agreement are included in this written document. Any changes or modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.
