The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a special meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the County's current culvert policy and existing graded roads to be paved. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

BELL WOODWORKS

The Board and representatives from Bell Woodworks discussed the eviction that has taken place on their space at the Industrial Park. Bell Woodworks asked for access to the building to be able to get their equipment out to complete the current jobs that they have. After much discussion took place, on a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to allow Bell Woodworks to pay \$9,000 of the amount owed plus a current month of rent and they would be allowed access to the property. The rest of the amount owed will be forgiven. If they get behind again in their rent the eviction process will begin again.
