

REGULAR MEETING
MAY 23, 2011
5:30 P.M.

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

GRANT AMENDMENT FOR ENERGY GRANT

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve transferring \$4,000 from supplies to personnel for the Energy Grant and to authorize Chairman Jones to sign all documents after state approval.

REQUEST BY EUGENE ALLEN TO RENT CANOES AT HAL ADAMS BOAT RAMP

Mr. Eugene Allen came before the Board to request the use of a 50 sq. ft. space at the Hal Adams Boat Ramp park to rent canoes and kayaks to further his business. He wants to try this out temporarily on the weekends for 30 days to see how business will be. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to allow Mr. Allen to use the space after he completes the application process and provides the Board with a copy of his liability insurance.

REQUEST FOR LDR EXCEPTION BY HURST

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to allow Donna Buchanan Hurst to cut a 5 acre parcel out of her 11 acre parcel to include the house. The Board is allowing this because the original transfer of the property was a result of a family transfer (parents to daughter) and the 11 acre parcel is adjacent to A-3, 1:5 ratio zoning on 2 sides.

DONNIE LAND – PUBLIC SAFETY

Mr. Donnie Land discussed several items with the Board. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve hiring David Keen for the Fire Department and as an EMS Driver. The Board held a discussion with Trevor Hicks and others on allowing EMS to participate in the FACT Program for Volunteer Fire Department certification. After a lengthy discussion, on a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to table this item.

PAST DUE SOLID WASTE ACCOUNTS

Mr. Bobby Johnson discussed the past due Solid Waste accounts on individuals that are deceased. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Mr. Johnson remove the names on the list that are deceased.

FELTON HOWARD, REQUEST FOR A SPRAY FIELD

Mr. Felton Howard came before the Board to discuss the status of his request for a spray field on his property to spray the “gray water” and not the sludge. Adjoining landowners also appeared at the meeting to voice their opposition to the spray fields. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Howard’s application for a spray field.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2006-04

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Lamb the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read the proposed amendment to Ordinance 2006-04 by title only again, as this was continued from the April 25, 2011 meeting. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the amendment pending Mr. Marvin Buchanan providing the Board with a map of the area.

ROAD CLOSING PETITION BY JOHN ANDREWS

The Board reviewed and discussed a road closing petition by John Andrews. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to reject his petition and have him re-apply to clarify the petition.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills, with the exception of the B’s Starters and Alternators bill and the Paul Lamb bill:

General Fund - \$44,592.45

Industrial Park - \$59.76

E911 Fund - \$125.00

Capital Projects Fund - \$672.23

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with Mr. Lamb abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Paul Lamb bill in the amount of \$691.00. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Hamlin, with Mr. Byrd abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the B's Starters and Alternators bill in the amount of \$150.00.

HARDENBERGH BOAT RAMP

The general consent of the Board, the Hardenbergh Boat Ramp will be closed until grant inspection passes. The Board asked Mr. Scott Sadler to barricade the entrance until the inspection is complete.

ADJOURN

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

ORDINANCE NO. 2011- 01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING LAFAYETTE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2006-04 TO REMOVE CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM THE SEPARATE ZONING DISTRICT CALLED A PLANNED RURAL RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT CREATED BY SUCH ORDINANCE; AMENDING THE ZONING ATLAS OF THE COUNTY TO REFLECT THE CREATION OF THIS PLANNED RURAL RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Lafayette County (hereinafter the "County") is a non-charter county as that term is used in Article VIII, Section 1(f), Florida Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, the County is given its home rule powers by the Florida Constitution, Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, and other provisions of Florida Law; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County, (hereinafter the "Board") is the governing body of the County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the County's home rule powers, Sections 125.01(1)(g-h), Florida Statutes and Part II of Ch. 163, Florida Statutes, the "Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulations Act", and other applicable provisions of law, the County has adopted and is implementing the Lafayette County Comprehensive Plan (hereinafter the "Comprehensive Plan") and the Lafayette County Land Development Regulations (hereinafter the Land Development Regulations") in the unincorporated area of the County; and,

WHEREAS, Sections 4.18 of the Land Development Regulations provides for a separate zoning district called a Planned Rural Residential Development (hereinafter the "PRRD"); and,

WHEREAS, the Board has previously enacted its ordinance No. 2006-04, which created

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a PRRD on certain real property located in Lafayette County, Florida more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land in Sections 23, 26, 27, 28, 33 and 34, Township 3 South, Range 10 East and Sections 2 and 3, Township 4 South, Range 10 East, Lafayette County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, some of the owners of portions of the PRRD Property have requested that

their portions of the PRRD Property be removed from and no longer be governed by the PRRD;
and,

WHEREAS, the Board has held a properly noticed public hearing as required for the
adoption of an ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the above request and all of the matters presented
at the above referenced public hearing prior to the adoption of this ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the requested amendment to the PRRD is in
conformance with the Land Development Regulations and the Comprehensive Plan and would
promote the public health, safety, morals, order, comfort, convenience appearance, prosperity
and/or or general welfare and therefore that the requested amendment of the PRRD will be in the
best interest of the citizens of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has complied with all other requirements imposed by Florida law
for the enactment of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
LAFAYETTE COUNTY:

1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into this ordinance as if restated herein
and constitute the legislative findings and intent of the Board of County Commissioners
(hereinafter the "Board") of Lafayette County (hereinafter the "County").

2. Lafayette County Florida Ordinance No 2006-04 is hereby amended, altered and
changed so that the real property controlled by the PRRD established by Lafayette County
Ordinance No. 2006-04 shall hereafter only be that portion of the PRRD Property lying outside
of the following described property:

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PARCEL A

A parcel of land in Sections 2 and 3, Township 4 South, Range 10 East, Lafayette County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

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of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 10 East; thence N 01° 02'40"W a distance of 663.49 feet to the Northeast corner of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said section 2; thence S 89°29'18" W a distance of 1322.65 feet to the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said section 2; thence N 01°02'11" W distance of 662.29 feet to the Northeast corner of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 4 South, Range 10 East; thence S 89°28'47" W a distance of 670.05 feet to the Southeast corner of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section 3; thence N 01°03'27" W a distance of 1325.48 feet to the Northeast corner of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section 3; thence S 89°33'23" W along the North line of said Section 3 a distance of 4693.84 feet to close on the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described parcel contains 305.24 acres.

(The "Removed Property" – Parcel A)

And PARCEL B

That Portion of the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Lying North and West of NW Gulf Wind Road, That Portion of the S 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Lying West of NW Gulf Wind Road, the W 1/2 of N 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, the W 1/2 of S 1/2 of SE 1/4 of NE 1/4; All in Section 34, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, Lafayette County, Florida.

And

SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 in Section 34, Township 3 South, Range 10 East, Lafayette County, Florida.

(the "Removed Property" – Parcel B)

3. Hereafter the Removed Property shall not be controlled by the PRRD established by Lafayette County Ordinance No. 2006-04 nor the application for such PRRD nor the Final Development Plan as set out in the application for such PRRD.

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4. The County's Official Zoning Atlas is hereby amended, altered and changed to reflect that the PRRD established by Lafayette County Ordinance No. 2006-04 shall hereafter not include the Removed Property.

5. Parcel A shall be rezoned back to its original A-3 zoning.

6. Parcel B shall be rezoned back to its original A-1 zoning.

7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

8. It is declared to be the intent of the Board that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

9. This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

ORDAINED upon due motion, second, after discussion, by majority vote on May 23, 2011.

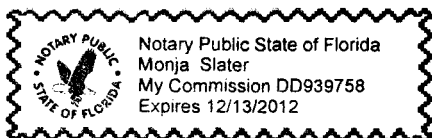
