

REGULAR MEETING  
MAY 27, 2014  
5:30 P.M.

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

#### **APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

#### **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FIVE YEAR WORK PLAN**

Mr. Jordan Green, with the Florida Department of Transportation, discussed the Five Year Work Plan with the Board. No action was taken on this issue.

#### **REPAIR TO MAINTENANCE VEHICLE**

Mr. Marcus Calhoun discussed repairs that need to be done to his Maintenance vehicle. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve repairing the vehicle.

#### **RE-ZONING OF PROPERTY**

Mr. Bobby Johnson discussed re-zoning a piece of property owned by Sidney Roberts from Agriculture to Commercial with the Board. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the property being re-zoned and to waive \$500.00 of the application cost.

#### **ROAD CLOSING PETITIONS**

The Board held a Public Hearing to discuss two road closing petitions that are adjoined to each other. Citizens that have property on that road came to the meeting and voiced their objections to the portions of the road being closed. After discussion with the citizens, on a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to table this Public Hearing until a later date.

**WORKSHOP FOR CITIZENS ON COUNTY ROAD 300**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to table the Workshop scheduled to be held with citizens who live on County Road 300 because of an incomplete survey on the area.

**LANTANA ROAD PROJECT**

The Board opened sealed bids for the Lantana Road project. The following bid was turned in: RV Duck Concrete, LLC - \$29,000.00. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a motion by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the bid pending the review and approval from Jack Husband.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH MADISON COUNTY**

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to discontinue their contract for Economic Development with Madison County effective September 30, 2014.

**SIMS FARM TIMBER**

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to advertise for RFP's for the sale of the timber located at the Sims Farm.

**DAY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT PROPERTY**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to withdraw the Board's offer for the property in Day for the Volunteer Fire Department.

**APPROVE THE BILLS**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

- General Fund - \$31,551.24
- Courthouse Renovation Reserve Fund - \$15,230.26
- Road & Bridge Secondary Fund - \$500,317.96
- Industrial Park Fund - \$1,208.65

**STATE OF EMERGENCY RESOLUTION**

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the State of Emergency Resolution for flooding throughout the county, retroactive to May 23, 2014.





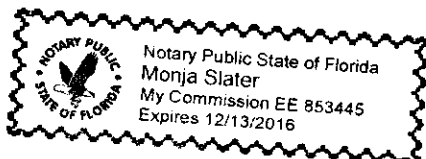
