The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

**BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS**

**SPECIAL EXCEPTION – NEW HOPE BAPTIST CHURCH**

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read Resolution 11-004 by title only. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution adopting a special exception for New Hope Baptist Church.

**SPECIAL EXCEPTION – T.W. BYRD'S SONS, INC.**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read Resolution 11-005 by title only. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution adopting a special exception for T.W. Byrd's Sons, Inc. Mr. Byrd did not vote on the matter due to him arriving at the meeting later in the morning from a doctor's appointment.

**REQUEST FROM GUY NIEBRUEGGE TO WAIVE SPECIAL  
ASSESSMENT FEE**

Mr. Guy Niebruegge came before the Board to request that his past due special assessment fee in the amount of \$3,410.06 (with interest) be waived because he is unable to pay it. After discussion, the Board decided to table this issue and look into it further and put it on the agenda for the next meeting.

**REQUEST TO WAIVE IMPACT FEES AND SPECIAL EXCEPTION FEES  
BY NEW HOPE BAPTIST CHURCH**

Mr. Marcus Calhoun gave the Board a letter of request to waive the impact fees for New Hope Baptist Church for campsites on the grounds of where their new church will be built. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the request to waive the impact fees. Mr. Calhoun also requested that their special exception fees in the amount of \$300.00 be waived, which they already paid. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve waiving the special exception fees also.

**ILLEGAL DUMPING AT COLLECTION SITE**

The Board discussed a recent problem with illegal dumping at the old landfill collection site. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson send a letter regarding past due fees and illegal dumping at the collection site to an individual who recently did not pay the entire amount of his bill.

The Board discussed the letter from Coppins Monroe concerning the clean-up of miscellaneous materials by Bass Assassins after the fire at the Industrial Park. No action was taken pending more information from all parties concerned.

**AMEND ORDINANCE REGARDING BUSINESS TAX**

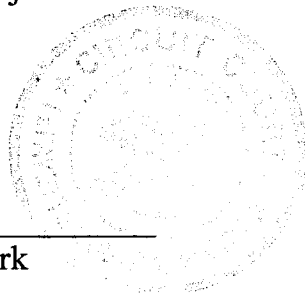



A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, SERVING AS THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, GRANTING WITH APPROPRIATE CONDITIONS AND SAFEGUARDS A SPECIAL EXCEPTION AS AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION 3.2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2000-5, ENTITLED LAFAYETTE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO THE PERMITTED USES WITHIN AGRICULTURE-3 ZONING DISTRICT AS PROVIDED WITHIN SECTION 4.5.5 TO PERMIT THE LOCATION OF A **16 SITE RV PARK** ON CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR REVOCATION OF THE SPECIAL EXCEPTION; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2000-5, entitled Lafayette County Land Development Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Land Development Regulations, empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Lafayette County, Florida, serving as the Board of Adjustment of Lafayette County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, to grant with appropriate conditions and safeguards or deny special exceptions as authorized under Section 3.2.4 of the Land Development Regulations;

WHEREAS, a petition for a special exception, SE11-004, as described, below has been filed with the County;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Land Development Regulations, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, held the required public hearing, with public notice having been provided, on said petition for a special exception, as described below, and considered all comments received during said public hearing and the Concurrency Management Analysis Report concerning said petition for a special exception, as described below;

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, has found that they are empowered under Section 3.2 of the Land Development Regulations to grant, to grant within an Agricultural-3 zoning district;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, has determined and found that the granting with appropriate conditions and safeguards of the said petition for special exception, as described below, would promote the public health, safety, morals, order, comfort, convenience, appearance, prosperity or general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, has determined and found that the petitioner has proposed ingress and egress to the property and proposed structures thereon for pedestrian safety and convenience, in a manner that will not have an undue impact on traffic flow and control, and access in case of fire or catastrophe;

Whereas, THE Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, has determined and found that the special exception, as described below, is generally compatible with adjacent properties, other property in the district and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, serving as the Board of Adjustment, has determined and found that:

- (a) the proposed use would be in conformance with the Comprehensive Plan and would not have an undue adverse effect on the Comprehensive Plan;
- (b) the proposed use is compatible with the established land use pattern;
- (c) the proposed use will not materially alter the population density pattern and thereby increase or overtax the load on public facilities such as schools, utilities, and streets;
- (d) the proposed use will not have an undue adverse influence on living conditions in the neighborhood;
- (e) the proposed use will not create or excessively increase traffic congestion or otherwise affect public safety;
- (f) the proposed use will not create a drainage problem;
- (g) the proposed use will not seriously reduce light and air to adjacent areas;
- (h) the proposed use will not adversely affect property values in the adjacent areas;
- (i) the proposed use will not be a deterrent to the improvement or development of adjacent property in accord with existing regulations; and
- (j) the proposed use is not out of scale with the needs of the neighborhood or the community

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, SERVING AS THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to petition, SE11-004 by New Hope Baptist Church requesting a special exception be granted as provided for in Section 4.5.5 of the Land Development Regulations, the Lafayette County Commissioners serving as the Board of Adjustments, Lafayette County, Florida, grants a special exception to permit the location of a **16 SITE RV PARK** in accordance with a site plan dated September 12, 2011 submitted as part of a petition dated September 12, 2011 and located on property described as follows:


**WHEREAS**, a delay in the issuance of tax notices may result in a disruption to the operations of the Lafayette County Taxing Authorities.



## WHO MUST FILE FORM 8B

This form is for use by any person serving at the county, city, or other local level of government on an appointed or elected board, council, commission, authority, or committee. It applies equally to members of advisory and non-advisory bodies who are presented with a voting conflict of interest under Section 112.3143, Florida Statutes.

Your responsibilities under the law when faced with voting on a measure in which you have a conflict of interest will vary greatly depending on whether you hold an elective or appointive position. For this reason, please pay close attention to the instructions on this form before completing the reverse side and filing the form.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 112.3143, FLORIDA STATUTES

A person holding elective or appointive county, municipal, or other local public office **MUST ABSTAIN** from voting on a measure which inures to his or her special private gain or loss. Each elected or appointed local officer also is prohibited from knowingly voting on a measure which inures to the special gain or loss of a principal (other than a government agency) by whom he or she is retained (including the parent organization or subsidiary of a corporate principal by which he or she is retained); to the special private gain or loss of a relative; or to the special private gain or loss of a business associate. Commissioners of community redevelopment agencies under Sec. 163.356 or 163.357, F.S., and officers of independent special tax districts elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis are not prohibited from voting in that capacity.
