**DISCUSS ADVERTISING FOR A CEI FOR THE FDOT SCOP AGREEMENT**


The Board discussed the FDOT SCOP Agreement on the CR 416 project, and the possibility of advertising for a CEI for the county road jobs. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to amend Darabi and Associates contract for design and engineering services on the CR 416 project. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to advertise for a CEI for the SCOP/SCRAP projects. This is a requirement by the Florida Department of Transportation that the projects be inspected by someone other than the engineer/designer on the project.

**SUWANNEE RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT – STORM WATER STUDY**



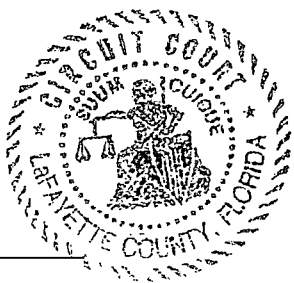
**ADJOURN**
