

REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 22, 2007
5:30 P.M.

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the commissioner's meeting room at the Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Charles Driver, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan.

PLANNING & ZONING

There was no business to discuss in the Planning and Zoning meeting. The meeting was adjourned.

OPEN REGULAR BOARD MEETING

The regular board meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Driver, the board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

DRIVEWAY POLICY FOR SUBDIVISIONS

Mr. Bobby Johnson, Lafayette County Building Inspector, went over a proposed driveway permit application for subdivisions with the Board of Commissioners. On a motion by Mr. Driver and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the board voted unanimously to set the fee for driveway permits at \$35.00. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the board voted unanimously to adopt the policy for driveway permits in subdivisions.

NOVEMBER AS EPILEPSY AWARENESS MONTH

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Driver, the board voted unanimously to declare November as Epilepsy Awareness Month.

NATIONAL WEATHERIZATION DAY

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the board voted unanimously to declare October 30th as National Weatherization Day.

LIBRARY OPERATING HOURS

Ms. Kay Green, Lafayette County Librarian, submitted a letter requesting that the operating hours of the library be changed so that the library can be closed on Saturdays. The

board held discussion on this issue. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the board voted unanimously to have the library keep a record of how many people come to the library on Saturdays for November and December and report back in January 2008 for reconsideration.

LEENETTE McMILLAN, VARIOUS ITEMS

Ms. Leenette McMillan, Lafayette County Attorney, discussed the following items with the board:

- 1) Proposed Impact Fee Ordinance – On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the board voted unanimously to advertise the proposed ordinance.
- 2) Grant Agreements with FBIP regarding the Hal Adams Boat Ramp Grant. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously to approve the agreements.

WARRANT LIST

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the board voted unanimously to approve the following bills, with the exception of the Pridgeon's Garage bill and the Byrd's Power Equipment bill:

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Driver, with Mr. Byrd and Mr. Pridgeon abstaining, the board voted unanimously to approve the Pridgeon's Garage bill in the amount of \$479.04 and the Byrd's Power Equipment bill in the amount of \$122.47 to be paid.

APPOINT FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES DESIGNEE

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Driver, the board voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Donnie Hamlin as the Lafayette County Designee for the Florida Association of Counties legislative committee.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Driver, the board voted unanimously to adjourn.
