APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

Mr. Donnie Land, Public Safety/Industrial Park department head, discussed the Local Mitigation Strategy and other various items with the Board, no action was taken on this issue. He also discussed with the Board the possible expansion of the Industrial Park along with Mr. Elvoy Land and Mr. Angie Ceraso. They discussed a possible 140' x 100' expansion for a new company who is interested in creating up to 46 new jobs in Lafayette County. No action was taken on this issue.

Industrial Park Fund - \$1,921.70


DOT AGREEMENT TO CONSTRUCT BIKE TRAIL
