The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

**APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**PROPOSAL ON COUNTY ROAD 251 PROPERTY**

Susie Hudson gave the Board the proposal settlement and contracts on the County Road 251 property. The contracts have been signed by the buyers and the closing will be on October 31, 2018. On a motion by Mr. Pridgeon and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve the settlement statement.

**R.O. RANCH SURPLUS PROPERTY**

Glenn Biggerstaff discussed the R.O. Ranch with the Board, and the Suwannee River Water Management District wanting to declare it as surplus property to sell. He has been dealing with the family that helped with funding for the R.O. Ranch, and they want to be able to try to keep it open and want support from the Board to do so. The Board told him that they would take it into consideration. No action was taken on this issue.

**REQUEST TO ADVERTISE FOR NEW GARBAGE TRUCK**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve a request from Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, to advertise to receive bids on a new Garbage Truck.

**REQUEST TO SELL EXCAVATOR THROUGH ONLINE AUCTION SALE**

Scott Sadler requested to sell the 225 Caterpillar Excavator, that was already listed as surplus property, through an online auction company called Bigtruckbid, LLC that he has previously used. The company requests a 5% commission and the successful bidder is responsible for picking up the equipment. The Board asked Scott to also check with other auction companies on their policies and procedures and report back with that information.

**PROPERTY ON OLD BRIDGE ROAD**

Paul Lloyd, as agent for Charles Dickey, came back before the Board to discuss the property on Old Bridge Road and their issue with trying to get a septic tank put in on the property. Bill Jenkins, with the Health Department was also present at the meeting to speak on this issue. Mr. Jenkins said that he doesn't have all of the information yet on the denial of the septic tank permit for the Board on this property. Mr. Adams asked Robert Hinkle, Building Inspector, to contact Building Officials along the Suwannee River and ask them how they have handled issues similar to this one and to compile that information and report it back to the Board.

**REQUEST TO ATTEND CONFERENCE**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to allow Marty Tompkins, EMS Director, to attend an insurance conference on October 28-30, 2018. He said that J.C. Lawson will be in charge while he is attending the conference.

**OPEN SEALED BIDS ON ROAD PROJECTS**

The Board opened sealed bids on the following roads: CR 405, CR 425, CR 500, CR 480 and Monroe Avenue. The only bid submitted was from Anderson Columbia Company. The bids were as follows: CR 405 - \$3,332,030.29; CR 425 - \$481,248.08; CR 500 - \$876,021.76; CR 480 - \$485,218.64 (Alt. 1) and \$668,785.50 (Alt. 2); and Monroe Avenue - \$345,614.84, for a total amount of \$5,520,133.61. The Board agreed to have Mr. Frank Darabi review the bid and make a recommendation to the Board. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to hold a Workshop on Monday, October 29, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. to discuss these bids and also McCray Grade and Turkey Road.

**MOVE FIRST MEETING IN NOVEMBER FROM THE 12<sup>th</sup> TO THE 13<sup>th</sup>**

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to approve moving the first meeting in November from the 12<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. due to the Veteran's Day Holiday.
