On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve following bills:



On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

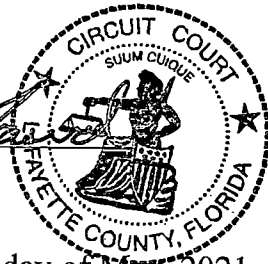
