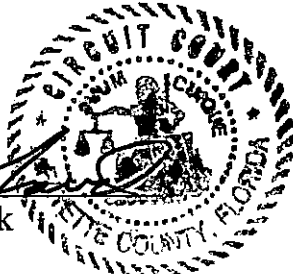
INTERVIEW APPLICANTS FOR CUSTODIAN


