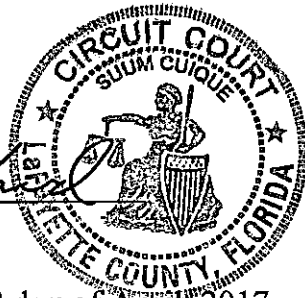
### ADJOURN


