
**BUILDING OFFICIAL POSITION**

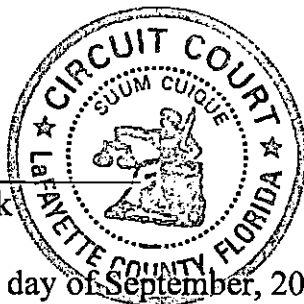
The Board discussed the Building Official vacancy. No action was taken on this issue.


**ADJOURN**
