SPECIAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 8, 2017 12:00 P.M.

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a special meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Thomas E. Pridgeon, Jr., Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-09-SP-1

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read Resolution No. 2017-09-SP-1 by title only. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the resolution declaring a state of emergency for Lafayette County due to Hurricane Irma.

UPDATE ON HURRICANE IRMA

Marc Land, Emergency Management Director, gave the Board an update on Hurricane Irma. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to allow the Emergency Operations Center to open the shelter at the appropriate time when the winds exceed 40 mph, and to leave this up to the discretion of the EOC Director, without needing further action by the Board.

Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, told the Board that the crews are ready and getting prepared for the storm.

Sampson Edwards, with the Town of Mayo, requested the use of the Board Room during the storm, in the event that the Town of Mayo is inoperable. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve the request.

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to close all county offices on Monday and Tuesday (September 11-12, 2017) for the storm, and to allow Scott Sadler to have his staff on call as they are needed, and to also offer them the option of receiving overtime pay or comp time for their work during the storm.

CANCEL REGULAR BOARD MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2017

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to cancel the regular Board Meeting on September 11, 2017, and reschedule all business to the next regular scheduled meeting on September 25, 2017.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:

REIMBURSEMENT FOR BUILDING PERMITS

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to allow applicants for electric poles and repairs, etc. that are due to Hurricane Irma to be able to apply for reimbursement from the county through the Building Department.

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.
