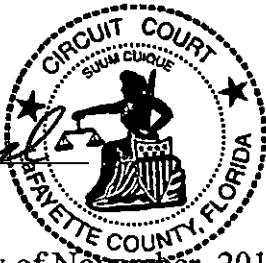
ADJOURN


