

REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 10, 2012

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The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's Meeting Room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Gail Garrard, Dist. 2; Commissioner Donnie Hamlin, Dist. 3; Commissioner T. Jack Byrd, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Lafayette County Attorney Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

REQUEST TO PURCHASE CULVERTS FOR CITIZENS

Mr. Scott Sadler suggested to the Board that the county provide the culverts as part of the Road Department installing driveways. The service will be funded by adding the cost of the culvert to the permit fee. The reason for this is that no local business provides culverts. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to adopt this procedure.

CDBG GRANT

Mr. Cecil Westbrook discussed the CDBG Grant with the Board. Mr. Westbrook said that there were \$58,000 in remaining funds for the Grant and that there was enough for one more house. He recommended Mrs. Rika Starling as the applicant to add. On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve renovating Mrs. Starling's home and close out the grant.

REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT BY JOSHUA REED

Mr. Joshua Reed sent the Board a letter requesting reimbursement for a bill for damage to his vehicle on a county road. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Hamlin, the Board voted unanimously to deny his request.

RESOLUTION FOR FACT

On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution for FACT.

ADOPT THE HOLIDAY CALENDAR FOR 2013

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Holiday Calendar for 2013.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN RESOLUTION

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read the Emergency Management Plan Resolution. On a motion by Mr. Hamlin and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution.

APPROVE THE BILLS

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills, with the exception of the Hamlin Brothers and B's Starters and Alternators bill:

General Fund - \$305,333.26

Emergency 911 Fund - \$805.25

Industrial Park Fund - \$12,622.30

Courthouse Renovation Reserve Fund - \$662.17

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, with Mr. Hamlin abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Hamlin Brothers bill in the amount of \$95.00.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Garrard, with Mr. Byrd abstaining, the Board voted unanimously to approve the B's Starters and Alternators bill in the amount of \$250.00.

AUGUST BUILDING DEPARTMENT/SOLID WASTE REPORT

On a motion by Mrs. Garrard and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the August Building Department/Solid Waste reports.

ADJOURN

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

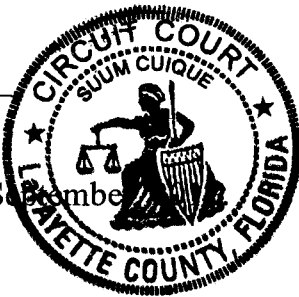


WHEREAS, the FACT Board has determined, after careful consideration and after receiving advice from outside advisors, that no legal or statutory requirements exist that require both audits; and

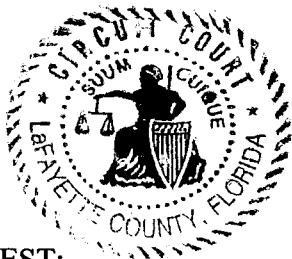
WHEREAS, Lafayette County, Florida, has developed an emergency management plan in accordance with Florida Statute 252.38(1)(a); and

Your responsibilities under the law when faced with voting on a measure in which you have a conflict of interest will vary greatly depending on whether you hold an elective or appointive position. For this reason, please pay close attention to the instructions on this form before completing the reverse side and filing the form.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 112.3143, FLORIDA STATUTES

A person holding elective or appointive county, municipal, or other local public office **MUST ABSTAIN** from voting on a measure which inures to his or her special private gain or loss. Each elected or appointed local officer also is prohibited from knowingly voting on a measure which inures to the special gain or loss of a principal (other than a government agency) by whom he or she is retained (including the parent organization or subsidiary of a corporate principal by which he or she is retained); to the special private gain or loss of a relative; or to the special private gain or loss of a business associate. Commissioners of community redevelopment agencies under Sec. 163.356 or 163.357, F.S., and officers of independent special tax districts elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis are not prohibited from voting in that capacity.

For purposes of this law, a "relative" includes only the officer's father, mother, son, daughter, husband, wife, brother, sister, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, and daughter-in-law. A "business associate" means any person or entity engaged in or carrying on a business enterprise with the officer as a partner, joint venturer, coowner of property, or corporate shareholder (where the shares of the corporation are not listed on any national or regional stock exchange).

PRIOR TO THE VOTE BEING TAKEN by publicly stating to the assembly the nature of your interest in the measure on which you are abstaining from voting; *and*

WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER THE VOTE OCCURS by completing and filing this form with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who should incorporate the form in the minutes.

APPOINTED OFFICERS:

Although you must abstain from voting in the situations described above, you otherwise may participate in these matters. However, you must disclose the nature of the conflict before making any attempt to influence the decision, whether orally or in writing and whether made by you or at your direction.

IF YOU INTEND TO MAKE ANY ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE THE DECISION PRIOR TO THE MEETING AT WHICH THE VOTE WILL BE TAKEN:

- You must complete and file this form (before making any attempt to influence the decision) with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who will incorporate the form in the minutes. (Continued on other side)

APPOINTED OFFICERS (continued)

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- A copy of the form must be provided immediately to the other members of the agency.
- The form must be read publicly at the next meeting after the form is filed.
